

# Cat5 Level 11 Teacher's Guide

Grade 1 (Spring testing): March 1<sup>st</sup> – June 30 Grade 2 (Fall testing): September 1<sup>st</sup> – November 30

### Language and Mathematics Subtests

Please note that *Cat5 Level 11 subtests* cover the *Grade 1 curriculum*, so it is intended for students who have completed most of Grade 1. The Spring and Fall testing dates are noted above, please administer the tests within those timeframes.
